# Dear patient!

## Services

In addition to the usual screening and preventive care services covered by the statutory health insurance in Germany, we recommend the following screening options, which are tried and tested early-detection methods and go beyond standard screening technologies:

- Vaginal ultrasound
- Breast ultrasound
- Immunochemical faecal occult blood test
- NMP22 test
- Thin Prep cervical smear test
- HPV testing
- Bone density scans

These screens are covered by private health insurance policies. However, unfortunately, they are not covered by the statutory health insurance and will have to be paid for privately as so-called Individual Healthcare Services (known within the German healthcare system under the acronym “IGeL”).

We offer these “IGeL” services for the following reasons: In Germany, 43 000 women are diagnosed with breast cancer each year, 30% of these before the menopause, 34 000 women are affected by coloncancer, 10 600 are diagnosed with endometrial cancer, 10 000 with bladder cancer, 8 000 with ovarian cancer and 6 300 with cervicalcancer. 30% of all women develop postmenopausal osteoporosis.

With the help of modern diagnostic technology, early detection is possible, which has significantly improved therapeutic success in the treatment of serious conditions over recent years.

We believe that the only sensible preventive medical care lies in using the best and most up-to-date screening technology. We therefore place great emphasis on keeping abreast of the latest developments and technological advances.

Where required, we will be happy to arrange for further assessments and tests through colleagues with specific expertise or refer you to hospitals with which we have close links and where you will be well looked after.
